ADDENDUM

Under Maryland law, a child under six years of age who is admitted to child care must have appropriate screening for lead poisoning. Parents or guardians must submit evidence of this screening to the child care provider within 30 days of admission to care. A child's exposure and poisoning is represented by certain levels in a child's blood. A level above 10 ug/dl or more can help child care providers limit the effects this exposure on a child's development through the care that they provide.
